Take a First Look at Cadence, Adding Polished American Cuisine to Mid-Market

Get ready to cozy up to the faux fur-backed booths.

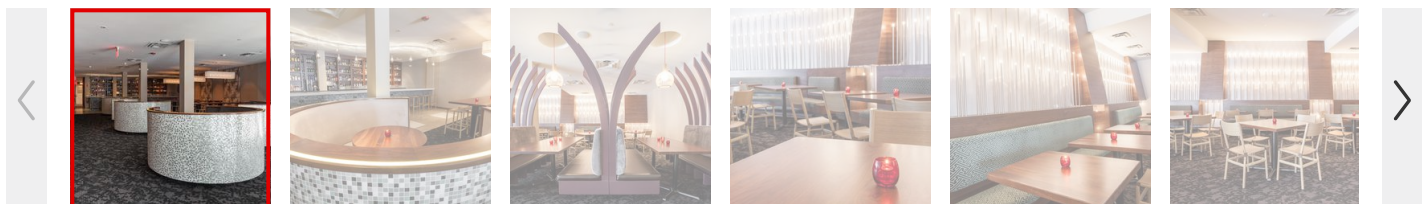

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Restaurateur Jay Bordeleau's (Maven) corner of Mid-Market **is now complete** with Wednesday, January 13's official opening of **Cadence**. The American restaurant is the sister portion of (and connected to) the **recently-opened live jazz cocktail bar, Mr. Tipple's Recording Studio**, but it's an entirely different feel inside. Unlike Mr. Tipple's funky vibes, Cadence has a more refined atmosphere with grown-up elements

like faux fur-backed, wood claw-enclosed booths and a constellation-like wall light fixture from design studio [G. Paoletti Design Lab](#).

As for the food, chef **Joey Elenterio** (Wayfare Tavern, Chez TJ) is behind the stoves of this one, and he's created a playful, yet ambitious menu (in full below) divided into two precious categories (the vegetarian "In the Ground or From a Stem" and meat-forward "Above Ground or From the Water"). Each section has four courses with dishes like hand-cut fettuccine with turnip beurre fondue, persillade and rye bread crumbs and sturgeon and its caviar with sourdough creme fraiche, soft-cooked eggs and tarragon. Reservations for the four-course menu are made through [Tock](#), the ticketed system that Coi and Lazy Bear use, and for now are an all-inclusive \$49, but Bordeleau said that they may introduce variable pricing based on day, time and table popularity. If the tickets don't do it for you, there's a walk-in, a la carte menu (below) with slightly more approachable dishes like roasted & fried chicken and a melange of seafood. Cadence is open Monday through Saturday from 5 p.m. to 10 p.m.
